

MORE THAN 1,150 YEARS OF INNOVATION AND TRADITION

For over 11 centuries, the Monnaie de Paris, France's longest standing institution, has focused on striking coins as well as the production of metal artistic craftsmanship.

Today, the French Mint strikes currency coins for more than 40 countries in the world and produces diverse metal art objects in its parisian factory.

The emblematic building located at number 11 of the quai de Conti opens its doors to the public since 2017. First and last active factory in the heart of the capital city, the Monnaie de Paris reveals the secrets of metal, its artisans' techniques and know-how and exclusive treasures.

The Monnaie de Paris welcomes you inside its majestic neoclassical palace built in the end the XVIIIth century, to live a unique experience on French Excellence, at the crossroads of arts, know-how and industry.


Its indoor and outdoor spaces can be adapted to any kind of event: seminars, dinners, cocktails, conferences, business meetings, fashion shows...

A UNIQUE VENUE IN THE HEART OF PARIS

In the center of Saint-Germain-des-Prés neighbourhood, by the Seine, located between the Pont-Neuf and the Pont des Arts, this splendid palace, its courtyards and rooftop are exceptional spaces in the heart of the historical Paris.




A 117 meter-long facade by the Seine 9 000 m² open to the public 5 inner courtyards 11 state rooms

AN ARCHITECTURAL MASTERPIECE

In 1775, under the reign of Louis XVI, the Monnaie de Paris settled at number 11 of the quai de Conti, in Paris' VIth district. The building, one of its kind, was conceived by the architect Jacques-Denis Antoine, combining the grandeur of an Antique palace to the functionality of a factory designed for coin-striking, still active today. The neoclassical building has since been overhauled to reopen in 2017, and reveal its splendour and treasures to the public.

Climb the Escalier d'Honneur to discover the majestic Salon d'Honneur Guillaume Dupré and the succession of Salons sur Seine. In the inner courtyards, gaze at the Méridienne and the ornemental sculptures of the facade, witnesses of the thousand-year-old history of the institution. In the museum, admire the Grand Monnayage and the Fortune statue that keeps a close watch on the production since 1775.






THE SALON D'HONNEUR GUILLAUME DUPRÉ




At the top of the Escalier d'Honneur, the Salon d'Honneur Guillaume Dupré is a perfect witness of the "grand décor" period under the reign of Louis XV, directly inspired by the Renaissance and Baroque era italian models. Its remarquable architecture is completed by exceptional views over the Seine and the Louvre on one hand, and the Cour d'Honneur on the other hand.




THE SALONS SUR SEINE



This series of 11 perfectly preserved Salons from the XVIIIth century is the ideal intimist setting for your events, modular hence adjustable according to the number of guests. Adjoining the Salon d'Honneur Guillaume Dupré, these rooms offer a breathtaking view over the Seine.




THE MÉRIDIENNE GALLERY



This ground floor gallery is a vast space divided into several rooms, appropriate for a cocktail, an exhibition or the backstage of major events. This gallery crosses the building's East wing, from the Quai de Conti entrance to the Cour de la Méridienne.




THE COUR D'HONNEUR



Accessible via the Quai de Conti main entrance, the Cour d'Honneur is the biggest inner courtyard of the Monnaie de Paris. Surrounded by a 30-meterlong gallery, it occupies a symbolic place, between both main parts of the factory: the Salon d'Honneur Guillaume Dupré and the Grand Monnayage, the iconic place of French coin striking.




THE SIDE COURTYARDS



For major events, the side courtyards can be hired in addition to the Cour d'Honneur given they surround it. Besides, each one of these courtyards is suited to smaller events.




THE BOARDROOM AND ITS PATIO



On the roof of the Monnaie de Paris, the Boardroom hosts meetings, seminars or cocktails in a sober and confidential setting. Its patio, a well-kept secret on Paris rooftops, offers a panoramic view overlooking the Seine, with the Louvre, Notre-Dame and the Centre Pompidou as a backdrop.




THE GUÉNÉGAUD ROOM



Equipped with a video projector, microphones and a sound system, the Guénégaud room is perfectly suited to business meeting days or team building activities. Nearby the Museum entrance and the Cour de l'Or, it enables combining your event with a cultural activity or an outdoor cocktail party.



THE MUSEUM



The Museum, highlighting the know-how of the artisans of the Monnaie de Paris and metal working, constitutes an unusual space to organize your events in, divided into 10 rooms. During a cocktail party in the Main Room or the Collectors Room, your guests can wander in the whole Museum which is exclusively dedicated to them and where the treasures and manufacturing secrets of the institution are unveiled.

THE MUSEUM

An innovative and interactive experience, designed by the architect Philippe Prost around the Monnaie de Paris artisans, know-how and workshops

- the material: metal, from its raw state to finished products
- a French "savoir-faire" that has evolved throughout the centuries, at the junction between ancestral gestures and state-of-the-art techniques
- exceptional heritage collections

The Museum reveals the manufacturing secrets of the oldest institution in the world, still creating currency today as well as collector coins, medals, official decorations, jewelry and art casts. Engraving demonstrations and views on active art workshops help understanding the work of 150 passionate artisans.
